

**“40 VOICES” SHOWING**

This is to demonstrate that there are more than 40 other competing media “voices” in the relevant market area.

The relevant market area includes the twelve counties assigned by the Nielsen Station Index to the Clarksburg-Weston DMA: Barbour (community of Philippi); Doddridge (community of West Union); Gilmer (community of Glenville); Harrison (communities of Bridgeport, Clarksburg, Lost Creek, Salem and Shinnstown); Lewis (community of Weston); Marion (communities of Barrackville, Fairmont and Mannington); Randolph (community of Elkins); Ritchie (community of Harrisville); Taylor (community of Grafton); Tucker (community of Parsons); Upshur (community of Buckhannon); and Webster (community of Webster Springs). Additionally, in *Withers Broadcasting Company of West Virginia*, 21 FCC Rcd 5909 (2006), the Commission’s Media Bureau found that all cable television communities in Monongalia County, including Morgantown and Westover, were to be considered part of WDTV’s market.

In addition to the two other full power television broadcast stations in the relevant market area (WBOY-TV, Channel 12, Clarksburg, West Virginia, FIN 71220 and WNPB-TV, Channel 24, Morgantown, West Virginia, FIN 71676), there are forty (40) broadcast stations in the relevant market area, 11 AM stations, and 29 FM stations, that broadcast signals which are in competition with stations controlled by W. Russell Withers, Jr.:
