Compliance with Multiple Ownership rules prepared by Guy Smith, RF Engineer
in connection with application for non-directional operation for KSTQ

Arbitron Market Method

KSTQ(FM) is in the Lubbock, TX Arbitron Metro. Arbitron reports a total of 27 Radio Broadcast stations (commercial and noncommercial combined) in the Lubbock Metro as “home” stations, and Ramar has identified four additional operating full-power stations located in the Lubbock Metro.

Ramar owns four of these stations: KJTV(AM), KLZK(FM), KSTQ(FM) and KXTQ-FM. As ownership of up to 6 radio broadcast stations is permissible in a market having 15 to 29 stations, Ramar is clearly in compliance with section 73.3555(a) using the Arbitron Market method.

Interim Method

Page 2 of this exhibit shows the principal community contours of all radio broadcast stations serving the Lubbock market. Four of those stations, KLLL-FM, KQBR, KFMX-FM, and KZII-FM, share a common antenna and operate at the same power. The principal community contour for those stations is shown in red. Two stations, KONE and KMMX, also share a common antenna and are shown in yellow. The remainder of the FM stations' contours are in blue and all the AM stations are in green. All Ramar stations are shown in black.

It can be seen from the map that the principal community contours of all of the Ramar radio broadcast stations overlap, and the contours of 21 of the non Ramar stations overlap all of the Ramar stations. As Ramar is permitted to own up to 6 radio stations with 15 to 29 stations, the application is in compliance with Section 73.3555(a).
