Dear Mr. Crigler:

On behalf of Tichenor License Corporation (“Tichenor”), licensee of KLAT(AM), Houston, Texas, the purpose of this letter is to confirm that Tichenor and Pacifica Foundation, Inc. (“Pacifica”), licensee of radio station KPFT(FM), Houston, Texas, have reviewed the KPFT(FM) construction permit contained in FCC File No. BPED-19970527IE and have determined that it is unlikely that the power increase authorized therein will adversely impact the operations of KLAT(AM). Accordingly, the parties believe that requiring KPFT(FM) to conduct a partial proof of performance in connection with the license application would be unduly burdensome and is not necessary in this case. The parties also hereby agree that should Tichenor determine that the proposed KPFT(FM) facilities are causing any actual interference to KLAT(AM)’s operations, Pacifica will immediately rectify any such interference at its sole cost and expense. Pacifica may file this agreement with the Federal Communications Commission with its license application.
