TECHNICAL STATEMENT

1. This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Harrison Radio Stations, Inc. ("HRS"), licensee of KNWA, 1600 kHz, Bellefonte, Arkansas. HRS is submitting an application to decrease the daytime power of KNWA; as such, a Radio Market Analysis is needed. Principals of HRS have attributable interests in the licences of KCWD¹, Channel 241C2, Harrison, Arkansas; KOMT, Channel 298C0, and KPFM, Channel 288C2, Mountain Home, Arkansas; and KKTZ, Channel 228C3, Lakeview, Arkansas.² None of these stations are located in nor considered "home" in any rated market. Therefore, an analysis using the revised contour overlap rules is necessary. A map of the city grade contours of these stations is attached as Exhibit #1.

CONTOUR OVERLAP ANALYSIS MARKET REVIEW

2. Based on the overlap of the stations' contours, one market is created, consisting of AM station KNWA and FM stations KCWD and KOMT. Therefore, a study has been conducted to determine if ownership of these facilities complies with §73.3555 of the Commission's rules. The contours of the stations will be used to determine the number of other stations serving the defined market. The study will determine the number of other commercial AM and FM stations

2) KKTZ and KPFM do not have city grade contour overlap with KNWA. As such, they are not considered further.

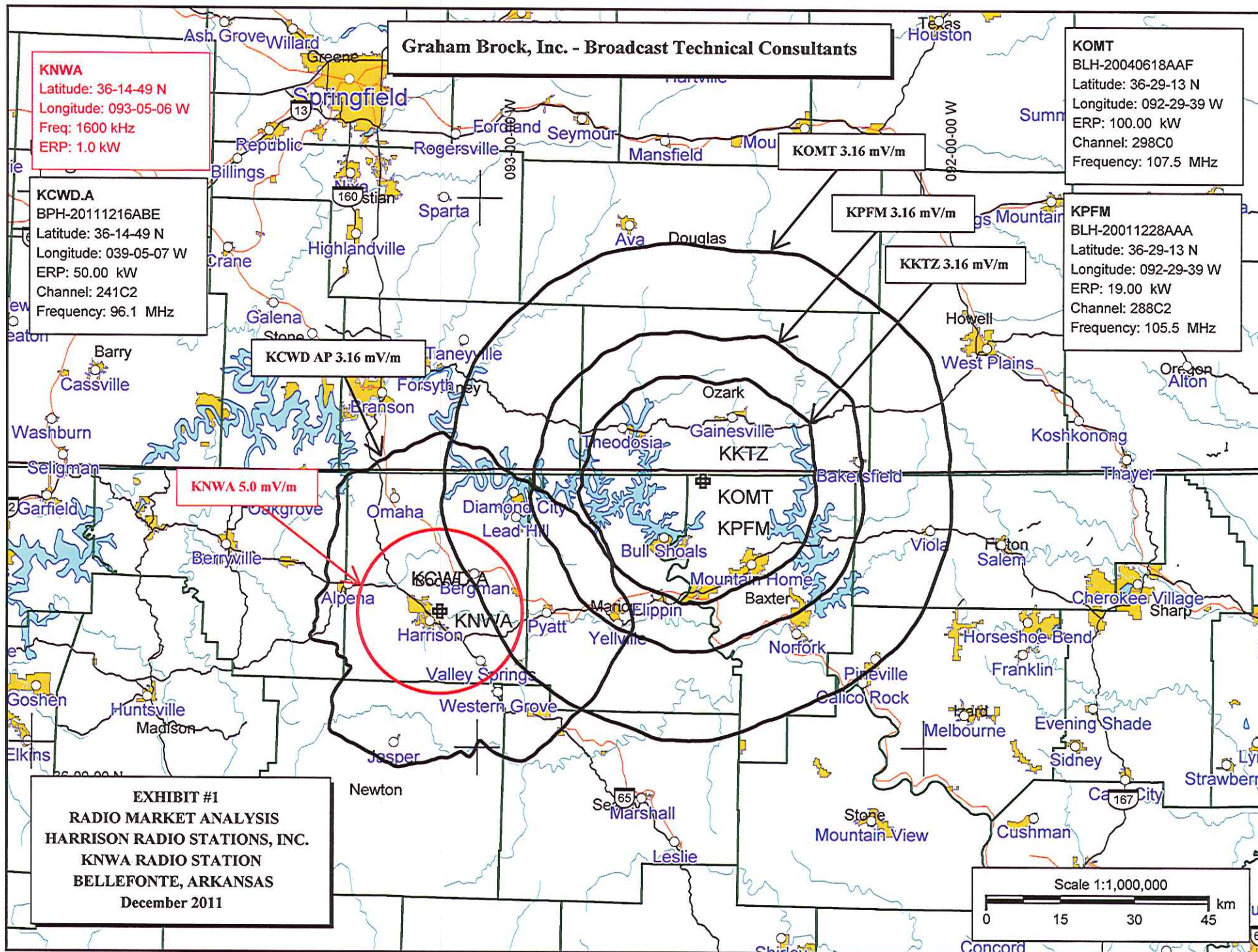
that either have transmitter sites within, or provide coverage to, the subject radio market. Only those stations with transmitter sites within 92.0 kilometers will be considered as contributors to the market. No other station in which HRS has interests will be considered, unless it is a subject station in the market under review. As the proposed city grade contour of KNWA is completely encompassed by the KCWD contour, the contours of KCWD and KOMT will be used to determine the number of other contributing stations serving the market. We will then add the subject stations in the relative markets.

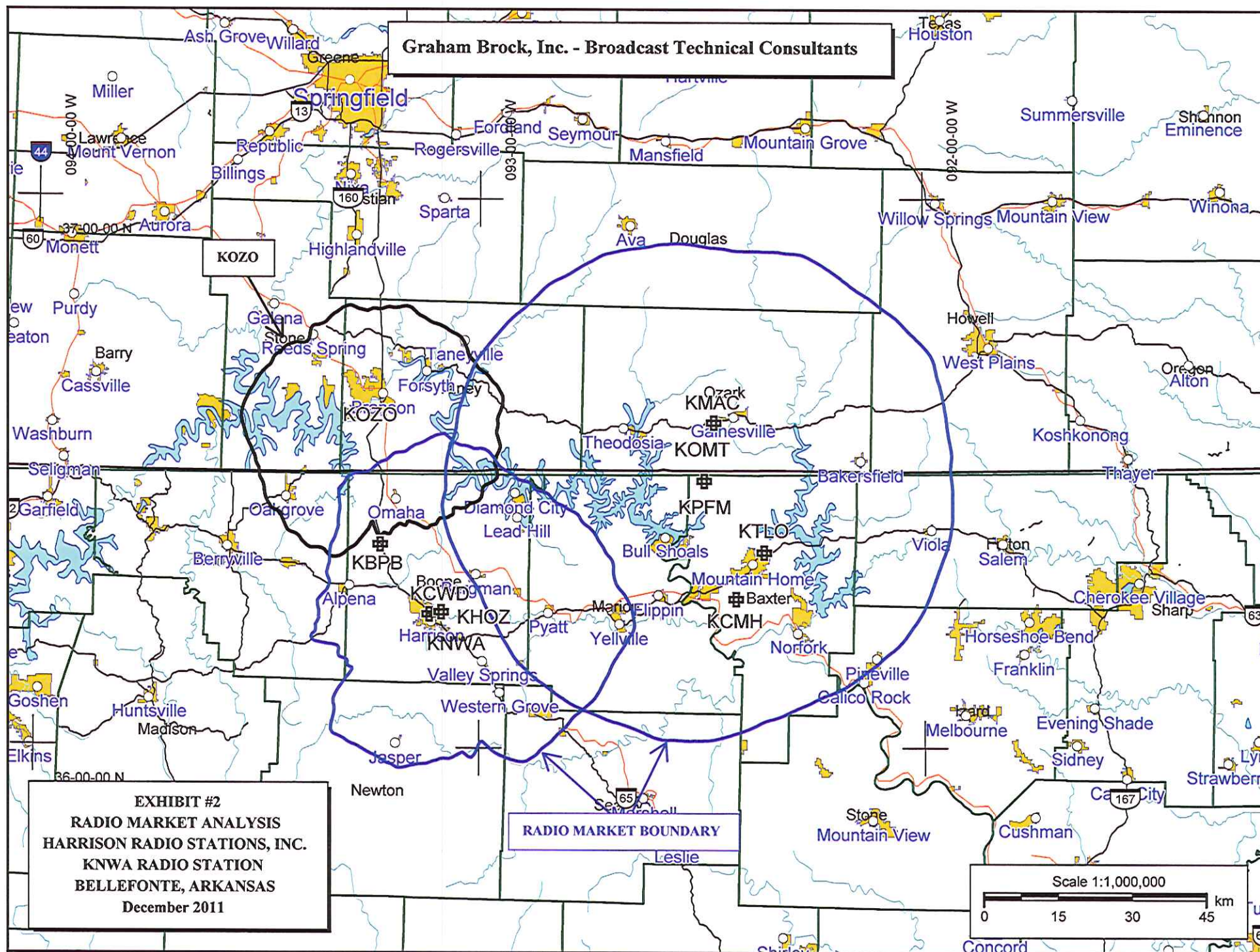
3. Exhibit #2 is a depiction of the other commercial and non-commercial stations within, or providing service to the Radio Market boundary. Exhibit #3 is a tabulation of the stations in the Radio Market. There are nine AM and FM stations, when the three subject stations are included.³ The number of stations depicted falls in the fourteen or fewer stations tier of §73.3555(a)(1)(iv) of the Commission's rules. At the fourteen or fewer stations level, common ownership or control of up to five stations, with no more than three in the same service is permissible, provided the number of stations to be commonly held does not exceed 50% of the stations in the market. As such, the Radio Market is in compliance with the Commission's multiple ownership rules, as detailed in §73.3555 of the rules.

4. Based on the compliance demonstrated in the non-rated market reviewed, the proposed application for KNWA is in compliance with the Commission's ownership rules.

3) There are additional stations in the market; however, they were not considered as there were sufficient stations, based on the number of facilities to be commonly held.

All data relating to AM and FM facilities in the relevant BIA/Arbitron market was determined using the BIA Financial Network, Inc. Media Access Pro, Version 4.6. BIA database. All data relating to AM and FM facilities was extracted from the Commission's CDBS database. We assume no liability for errors or omissions in either database which may be adverse to the information contained herein.



His qualifications are a matter of record before the Federal Communications Commission. He has been active in Broadcast Engineering since 1979.


