

## BYLAWS

### GOGEBIC RANGE SKI CORPORATION (COPPER PEAK, INC.)

#### ARTICLE I

##### NAME, OBJECTS AND COPORATE SEAL

- Section 1. Name: The name of this corporation is GOGEBIC RANGE SKI COPORATION, a Michigan nonprofit corporation (herein the "Corporation"). Per 08/04/88 Amendment to Articles of Incorporation, it became Copper Peak, Inc.
- Section 2. Objects: The objects of the Corporation are fully set forth in the Articles of Incorporation. In brief, the objects are to (a) promote and encourage skiing, ski jumping, and ski flying in the **Western Upper Peninsula of Michigan**; (b) to **interpret, educate, link, preserve and enhance the unique aspects of Copper Peak's natural, historical and cultural heritage**; (c) to **develop the Copper Peak facility into a four-season recreational, scenic and historic site for the benefit and enjoyment** [4/3/2001] of the public-at-large and to do so in such a manner that no part of the income or property of the Corporation shall inure to the private benefit of any member or other individual having a personal or private interest in the assets of the Corporation. In the event of the dissolution of the Corporation, its then remaining property shall be distributed and paid over to the **Charter Township of Ironwood and/or the Gogebic County Forestry Commission** [4/3/2001] to arrange for or to undertake the operation and maintenance or other disposition of the Corporation's facilities for the use of the public-at-large.
- Section 3. Seal: The corporate seal shall consist of two (2) concentric circles between which shall be the name of the Corporation and in the center of the inner circle shall be inscribed the year of incorporation and the words "Corporate Seal." A facsimile of the seal is impressed in the margin of this page of the Bylaws.

#### ARTICLE II

##### MEMBERS AND MEETINGS OF MEMBERS

- Section 1. Regular Membership Categories: There shall be two categories of regular memberships, **annual** or multiple annual, and **life**. Annual memberships shall be from the date of payment of dues to a period of one year, or multiple years, and life memberships shall be from the date of payment of dues for the natural life of the member. - Section 2. Membership Eligibility and Rights: Regular memberships shall be open to all interested individuals eighteen (18) years of age or older upon payment of dues to the Treasurer of the Corporation. Dues shall be set by the Board of Directors.
