

STATEMENT of JAMES H. KEMMAN

James H. Kemman, an employee of Electronics Research, Inc., states that he served as project coordinator for the development, manufacture, and installation of the antenna and transmitter combiner system furnished by Electronics Research, Inc. for four FM broadcast stations (KPLU, KLSY, KMPS, and KRPM), and located on West Tiger Mountain near Seattle, Washington. A key characteristic of this system is that it is capable of being expanded to accommodate the transmissions of additional stations. To this end, antenna radiation pattern measurements were taken at additional frequencies which are allotted to the general Seattle - Tacoma area.

Mr. Kemman states that he was and is familiar with all aspects of the project, that he was present on-site during the installation of the antenna, and that the same was installed by personnel of Seacoma Communications in accordance with instructions provided by Electronics Research, Inc. Mr. Kemman further states that he inspected the completed installation, and that he is satisfied that it duplicates the test installation which was developed under his supervision at the Electronics Research, Inc. test facilities.
