On February 1, 2010, the licensee as addressed above was sent the following deficiency letter:

We are currently processing your above-referenced application. Our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. WSPY-LP, Plano, IL. – BLTTL-19900514IR

You are hereby given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve these specified interference problems within (30) days from the date of this letter. Amendments must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.

Our records indicate that an amendment was filed February 4, 2010, specifically to resolve the interference issue as addressed in the above deficiency letter. Our current engineering analysis with the amended specifications taken into account reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to still cause interference to the following facilities:

1. WSPY-LP, Plano, IL. – BLTTL-19900514IR

Based on the results of the engineering analysis and the continued interference to the same station as referenced in the original 30 day deficiency letter, the above referenced application is considered incomplete and IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
