ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

The proposed construction will not have a significant environmental impact. The proposed transmitter will operate into an existing antenna requiring no modifications to the tower. Calculations of RF Radiation levels have been performed in accordance with OST Bulletin No. 65, Edition 97.1, dated August, 1997. The total calculated contribution from the proposed new operation, at any accessible point in the vicinity of the tower, other than on the tower, is below .25% of the permissible exposure level for the general public. This station is therefore categorically exempt from consideration in the evaluation of RF exposure levels from a multi-user tower. Past measurements have shown levels from this facility to be well below calculated levels.

Policies are in place at Ramar Communications II, Ltd. to reduce power and / or shut down transmitters as necessary, in order to avoid exposure of workers on the tower to RF levels in excess of ANSI guidelines.
