Request for Extension of Silent Special Temporary Authority NCE FM Station WWES(FM), Mount Kisco, NY (Facility ID 176621)

WAMC, licensee of noncommercial educational FM radio station WWES(FM), Mount Kisco, New York, respectfully requests a six-month extension of the station's existing Silent Special Temporary Authority ("STA"). WAMC applied for the original Silent STA in FCC File No. BLSTA-20200708AAD, indicating that WWES has been silent since June 14, 2020 due to equipment problems beyond the licensee's control. The FCC granted the STA on August 18, 2020, and the STA is currently due to expire on February 14, 2021.

The station's silent status resulted from an electrical outage. WAMC has been working towards equipment repairs as needed to restore operation over WWES and has made progress, but complications have precluded the completion of the process to date. WAMC is hopeful that it will be able to resume broadcasting over WWES in a matter of weeks, but given the impending STA expiration, it now seeks an extension of the existing Silent STA. An extension grant will serve the public interest by authorizing the station's continued silent status until such time as the technical problems can be fully addressed and resolved.

Station WWES is a noncommercial educational station and WAMC is a non-profit entity. WAMC and WWES are therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1116 of the FCC's rules and from FCC regulatory fees pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the FCC's rules.
