
It is with deep sadness that we must report the death of Angel E. Roman, president, director and majority shareholder of Aerco Broadcasting Corp. and Brothers Broadcasting Corp., on April 20, 2000.

It was expected that an involuntary transfer of control application (FCC Form 316) would have been filed by now, but the appointment of a personal representative of the decedent has not been completed. Under Puerto Rican law, this could be accomplished by a power of attorney, since no minor children are involved. It is expected that his son, Angel O. Roman-Lopez will become the estate's power of attorney and thus control the corporation until a disposition of the estate is determined, at which time a long form assignment (FCC Form 314) will be filed.

We will file the Form 316 as soon as Mr. Roman's appointment is completed under Puerto Rican law.
