

This exhibit contains the information required of winning bidders for construction permits, pursuant to Sections 1.2107(d), 1.2110(j), 1.2112(a) and 1.2112(b) of the Commission's rules.

**Section 1.2107(d): Joint Bidding Arrangement**

In Auction 62, the applicant herein, Jim McDaniel, cooperated with Educational Media Foundation ('EMF') through an informal joint bidding arrangement. Mr. McDaniel is a past station owner who previously operated a number of stations utilizing EMF programming. Hence, in the auction, EMF helped Mr. McDaniel locate possible stations that would be in areas where an EMF affiliated station would likely be well received. EMF helped Mr. McDaniel determine the economics of stations in targeted areas and thus the amounts he would bid for stations those areas, and worked with Mr. McDaniel in placing the actual bids.<sup>1</sup>

**Section 1.2110(j): Designated Entity Status/  
Section 1.2112(b): Small Business Status**

As indicated in Jim McDaniel's FCC Form 175 submitted for Auction No. 62, Jim McDaniel qualifies for a 35% new entrant bidding credit. Consistent with the requirements of 47 C.F.R. §73.5008, as an individual applicant, Jim McDaniel has no attributable interest in any other media of mass communications, as defined by Section 73.5008, and thus, the applicant is eligible for a 35% new entrant bidding credit.

**Section 1.2112(a): Parties in Interest**

Jim McDaniel is an individual applicant and thus there are no further party interests to disclose.
