Dear Mr. Shapiro

I am writing you to express the support of Trizec Holdings, Inc., building management for TH Tower Leasing LLC, Landlord at Sears Tower with respect to your application to the Federal Communications Commission for an improvement in the facilities of WFBT-CA, Channel 23, which broadcasts from atop the Sears Tower.

As you are aware, Sears Tower currently accommodates facilities that permit the transmission of eleven (11) of the new FCC-mandated digital television (DTV) stations, in addition to eight (8) NTSC and three (3) low power television (LPTV) stations from the antenna site acknowledged as providing superior coverage of the Chicago market. The finite nature of available space atop the building for new transmitting antennas required not only redevelopment of existing tower space, but in some cases the addition of new antenna mounting aperture.

Weigel Broadcasting's existing on-air operations of Channel 26, WCTU and Channel 23 WFBT-CA have been impacted by off-air periods required for worker access to install new television station antennas and transmission lines in areas above and adjacent to the existing Channel 26 and 23 transmitting antennas during this redevelopment process. Although Weigel had concerns that it's WFBT-CA Channel 23 coverage might be disadvantaged by elements of the redevelopment, Weigel did not raise impediments to installation and operation of the new stations, which might have delayed station installations, and therefore delayed the digital television implementation process in Chicago. Weigel has instead cooperated with the building and other broadcasters thereby allowing stations to meet deadlines for commencing digital operation. Furthermore, Weigel generously yielded aperture opportunities to other broadcasters, and therefore advanced the overall well being of the broadcast community in Chicago.


In an effort to accommodate a valuable tenant, Weigel Broadcasting, and eliminate Weigel's concern regarding any possible Channel 23 coverage diminishment from the redevelopment activities, building ownership and Weigel have agreed on an alternate aperture to accommodate the relocation of the WFBT-CA Channel 23 transmitting antenna. Both the existing antenna location and the new antenna location would allow the WFBT-CA antenna increased radiated power levels with no substantial change in the current Radio Frequency Radiation profiles which impact worker safety and activity on the building rooftop. We recognize Weigel's contribution to the advancement of DTV in

Chicago, and we fully support your efforts to obtain higher transmitting power authorization levels for WFBT-CA Channel 23.

The Sears Tower, through the efforts and cooperation of outstanding broadcasters like Weigel, provides a valuable community service platform to the Greater Chicago Metropolitan Area. We believe Weigel's power increase request will further enhance the outstanding service delivered to the public from Sears Tower.

I understand your desire to submit our views on this matter to the Federal Communications Commission in support of your application to increase power on WFBT-CA and we have no objection to your submitting this letter in that regard.
