Request for Extension of Reduced Power DTV STA NCE Station WSRE-DT, Pensacola, Florida (F.I.N. 17611)

The District Board of Trustees, Pensacola Junior College (“PJC”), licensee of noncommercial educational television Station WSRE(TV/DT), Pensacola, Florida, pursuant to Section 73.1635 of the Commission’s rules, hereby requests an extension of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to operate reduced power DTV facilities for the station.

The Commission originally granted this STA for the reduced power operation of WSRE-DT on February 6, 2002 (*see* FCC File No. BDSTA-20020128ABP, enclosed). The FCC most recently granted an extension of the STA in FCC File No. BEDSTA-20050613AGZ on August 2, 2005, and the STA is currently due to expire on February 2, 2006. Pursuant to Paragraphs 34-36 of the *Memorandum Opinion and Order on Reconsideration* in MM Docket No. 00-39, FCC 01-330 (rel. Nov. 15, 2001) (“*DTV Biennial Review Reconsideration*”), PJC respectfully requests a six-month extension of this STA.

PJC proposes no technical changes to its STA operation as outlined in the initial request and granted by the FCC. The STA specifies an effective radiated power of 287 kW, a height of radiation center above average terrain of 549.2 meters, and geographical coordinates of 30-36-40.3 N; 87-36-26.9 W. Grant of this extension would serve the public interest because it would allow PJC to maintain its existing digital noncommercial television programming for its WSRE(TV/DT) viewers in the Pensacola, Florida area.
