Dear Applicant:

We are currently processing your above-referenced application. Our preliminary engineering review reveals that the proposed facility protected contour does not overlap with the protected contour of the licensed facility file number BLDTL-20081006AAJ. The contours as referenced above must overlap in order for the proposed modification to be considered as a Minor Change.

In addition to the above referenced contour issue, your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. KTVJ-LP, Petaluma, CA. – BMPDVL-20091104AAF & BDISDVL-20090108ADX

We acknowledge the receipt of attachment 11 waiver agreement from Mr. Joseph Fiori dated September 21, 2009. The waiver of interference from Mr. Fiori specifically references acceptance of interference to his construction permit BNPDVL-20090825BIS. The interference acceptance agreement from Mr. Fiori must reference that he accepts interference caused to the two construction permits as shown above for station KTVJ-LP.

You are hereby given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve the specified protected contour problem and the interference issue within (30) days from the date of this letter. Amendments must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.
