CHANGE OF AUTHORIZED COMMUNITIES STATEMENT  
KEZZ MASONVILLE, COLORADO

The applicant, Kevin J. Youngers, seeks to modify the CP of KEZZ (facility I.D. 165959, BNPH-20060310ADJ) at Walden, Colorado on channel 231C2, to minor change its authorized community from Walden to Masonville, Colorado. He also seeks to change his transmitter location. He is proposing a change of channels and class of operation from 231C2 to 230A.

The minor change of the authorized community is pursuant to the new provisions of MB Docket 05-210 which becomes effective on January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2007. This docket allows for city of license changes, under certain provisions, to be filed as a minor change application on FCC form 301 for AM and FM broadcast stations.

Kevin J. Youngers believes this application meets the provisions under this new docket for a change in authorized communities for KEZZ. The docket emphasizes the desire to avoid any losses of service to communities while providing the most efficient usage of spectrum. KEZZ was acquired in auction 62 but has not yet been constructed. Therefore, if the authorized community is changed from Walden to Masonville, Walden will experience no actual loss of service from what it is currently receiving and will continue at its present service level of nine primary signals from stations in other communities. The proposed new community, Masonville, Colorado, does not have a commercial AM, FM or TV station authorized to it, thus, it will be the community's first local service. According to the U.S. Census data for 2000, Masonville has an estimated

population of 500. Walden has been declining from a population of 890, 1990 U.S. Census, to a population of 734, 2000 U.S. Census. Thus, the public interest supports a change of allotments from Walden, which will remain at its current licensed service level, while Masonville will benefit from its first local service.

Under the Instructions for the FCC form 301, under item 18, it calls for the following information to be included:

- 1) If new technical facilities are proposed, the area and population with the proposed 70 dbu and 60 dbu contours of the station: In this case, the population within the current contours of KEZZ at Walden is: 60 dbu – 14,634 persons and an area of 7,873 sq. km, 70 dbu – 1,500 persons and an area of 3,038 sq. km. The new proposed contours for KEZZ at Masonville will be: 60 dbu – 256,534 persons and an area of 1,994 sq. km, 70 dbu – 207,388 persons and an area of 631 sq. km.
- 2) The number of stations licensed to the proposed new community of license: There is no commercial AM, FM or TV station licensed to Masonville, Colorado. This will be the community's first local service.
- 3) The number of stations providing protected service to the proposed community of license: There are 20 FM stations that cover the new community with 60 dbu service or greater. There are 24 AM stations that cover the new community with 0.5 mv/m coverage or greater.
- 4) The population, according to the latest Census Data, of the proposed community of license: In this case, the community of Masonville, Colorado, is estimated at 500 persons according to the 2000 U.S. Census data.

- 5) Where relevant to establish the precondition of a licensable community, a description of the civic, cultural, religious, social and commercial attributes of the proposed community of license: Masonville, Colorado, has its own zip code of 80541.
- 6) Any other information deemed relevant: Masonville is home to the Buckhorn Presbyterian Church.
