Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed June 15, 2006, on behalf of Bible Broadcasting Network, Inc. ("BBN"). BBN requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on December 23, 2005, to operate Station WYFZ with reduced power.¹ In support of the request, BBN states that both the new transmitter and antenna which it ordered and received had problems which prevented their use by the station.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

¹ WYFZ is licensed for operation on Channel 217A (91.3 MHz) with effective radiated power of 0.9 kilowatt (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 97 meters.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WYFZ may continue to operate with reduced power. BBN must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. BBN must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **November 16, 2007**.
