Re: **Notice of Interference Acceptance at Jackson, MN**

Dear Dave:

I understand that Cooperative Television Association of Southern Minnesota ("CTV") plans to file an application with the FCC to increase power of CTV's digital Station **K49JU-D, Jackson, MN (Facility ID 167247)**. Please be advised that Blue Earth-Nicollet Faribault Cooperative Electric Association's ("BENCO") Station K61GE, Jackson, MN (Facility ID 5899), which has a displacement construction permit for analog Ch. 50 (callsign K50KL; File No. BDISTTL-20060720ACY), plans to file an application with the FCC to flash-cut K61GE to Ch. 50D.

To the extent interference may be predicted from the proposed modified facilities from K49JU-D to K50KL (whether as an analog or a digital operation), BENCO hereby agrees to accept interference from the modified K49JU-D facilities.

You have BENCO's permission to file a copy of this letter with the FCC in connection with CTV's application for power increase for Station K49JU-D.
