### **Southern Development Foundation-Field Office Community Radio Station**

As stated in its articles of incorporation, Southern Development Foundation (SDF) is a non-profit organization founded in Washington, DC, November 7, 1972.

The purpose of SDF according to its articles of incorporation is to operate exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including but not limited to providing research and educational programs, technical assistance, and expertise to low-income and minority people to help improve their economic and social conditions.

SDF's objectives are to build:

- 1) strong communities through community development
- 2) cooperative businesses
- 3) technical education and training
- 4) rural housing initiatives
- 5) Zydeco music presentation
- 6) South Louisiana rural heritage interpretation
- 7) small farm demonstration projects.

The educational programs of SDF will be extended by the operation of a low power radio station. The radio station will educate participants and listeners about community events, the diverse aspects of the life and culture of Opelousas, LA, facilitate discussions regarding community concerns along with showcasing music from artists of the culture and area of Opelousas.
