

Agreement of Understanding

Between

KVIE, INC.

AND

EDUCATIONAL PUBLIC RADIO, INC

This agreement is entered into as of the 14th day of September 2006 by and between KVIE, Inc. A California nonprofit public benefit corporation, (hereinafter referred to as KVIE), and KLSI et al, a non-commercial FM station (hereinafter referred to as KLSI).

KVIE and KLSI hereby enter into this agreement in accordance with the requirements specified by Federal Communications Commission Rules and Regulations Part 73.525.

KVIE is concerned with protecting our members and viewers from FM interference, both now and in the future. KVIE will agree to the proposed KLSI transmitter application under the following criteria:

1. Frequency is 89.3 MHz
2. ERP is 8.0 Watts, Circular Polarization,
3. Antenna elevation shall not exceed 581 meters AMSL and shall be located at coordinates:
Latitude: 37-33-44 Longitude: 122-28-46 .
4. KLSI specifically agrees to remedy properly verified cases by competent, trained technical personnel of off-the air KLSI interference to the KVIE signal within the affected KLSI area. Notch type coaxial cable filters equivalent to Microwave Filter Company Model 5KFM-89.3 will be obtained as needed to remedy specific cases in properly installed TV receiver systems. KLSI shall act in good faith to expeditiously assess and remedy bona fide problems of interference. If KLSI is unable to significantly reduce interference over a large coverage area KLSI will take other steps that may include reducing power or going off-air.
5. Beginning from the date of transmission from the new site, KLSI shall advertise weekly for 8 weeks, in a local newspaper stating: "Educational Public Radio, INC. is transmitting with a new antenna in the Moss Beach California area on 89.3 MHz and may cause interference to KVIE, Channel 6 in Sacramento. If you are experiencing interference from KLSI to KVIE, Channel 6 call Educational Public Radio, Inc. / KLSI at 1-888-5QFMQFM during business hours."


6. Beginning from the date of transmission from the new site, KLSI shall make two announcements a day, one of them during "prime-time" hours for a period of 8 weeks as follows:

"KLSI Radio is transmitting with a new antenna in the Moss Beach, CA area on 89.3 MHz and may cause interference to KVIE, Channel 6 in Sacramento. If you are experiencing interference from KLSI-FM to KVIE, Channel 6, call KLSI Radio at 1-888-5QFMQFM during business hours."

7. A copy of the daily logs containing announcements and copies of newspaper advertisements shall be mailed to KVIE, to the attention of the Manager of Engineering, monthly covering the time frame of the notice.
8. A log of interference calls with action taken shall be kept and a copy mailed to;

9. Educational Public Radio, Inc. has committed to being a "good neighbor" broadcaster in the past, correcting reception problems in a prompt and efficient manner. KVIE wishes to continue the cooperation with Educational Public Radio, Inc.
