Dear Wade:


I understand that Blue Earth-Nicollet Faribault Cooperative Electric Association ("BENCO") is planning to file applications with the FCC to: (1) displace Station **K16GL**, Jackson, MN (Facility ID 5895), to digital Channel 36-D, and (2) flash-cut Station **K61GE**, Jackson (Facility ID 5899) to Channel 50-D (since BENCO has a construction permit for displacement of K61GE to analog Channel 50 (K50KL; BDISTTL-20060720ACY)).

Regarding BENCO's displacement application at (1) above, Federated Rural Electric Association ("FREA"), licensee of Station K57IX, Jackson, MN (Facility ID 21285) has a displacement construction permit for analog Ch. 35 (Callsign K35IZ; FCC File No. BDISTTL 20060720ACV) and plans to file a digital flash-cut application for Channel 35-D. FREA hereby agrees to accept interference that BENCO's operations on Channel 36-D may cause to FREA's operations on analog Channel 35 or Channel 35-D.

Regarding BENCO's flash-cut application at (2) above, FREA, licensee of analog Station K51EN, Jackson, MN (Facility ID 21284), hereby accepts interference that BENCO's operation on Channel 50-D may cause to K51EN.

You have FREA's permission to file copies of this letter with the FCC in connection with BENCO's applications referenced above.
