

Engineering Statement

Application for LPFM Station

The following statement is submitted to demonstrate compliance with §73.827.

The FCC ULS was searched for translators within 2 km of Sutro Tower. Two translators, both co-located at Sutro Tower, were found.

The FCC CDBS shows K205BM with the Primary Station Call Sign KLVS. CDBS shows KLVS transmits on 107.3 MHz.

The FCC CDBS shows K281BU with the Primary Station Call Sign KLVS or KHRI depending on which page is shown. CDBS shows KLVS transmits on 107.3 MHz and KHRI transmits on 90.7 MHz.

Therefore the instant application complies with §73.827 (a) in that the proposed LPFM station is more than third-adjacent to either primary station.
