

**Exhibit E-5
Multiple Ownership Study**

This exhibit has been included to demonstrate that the proponent would be in compliance with the provisions of Section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules. The proponent would control two facilities from the same site, which would have identical 70 dBu service contours. One of the allocations for which the proponent is filing is the Ocean Shores, Washington allocation, with the other being the Westport, Washington allocation.

Since both facilities would have identical 70 dBu service contours, it is apparent that both facilities would have common overlap with each other. There are no other facilities in the vicinity in which College Creek would have an attributable or cognizable interest. Since both of these facilities would be licensed to communities outside of Arbitron rated markets, their common overlap constitutes a market for consideration.

It is therefore necessary and sufficient to demonstrate that the proponent would control not greater than fifty percent of the stations serving the market. The map attached to this exhibit demonstrates that there are at least three other full power facilities whose principal community coverage contour would overlap with the principal community coverage contour of the proposed facility. As a result, it is respectfully submitted that a sufficient number of stations serve the

market, and the proponent would be in compliance with the provisions of Section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules.

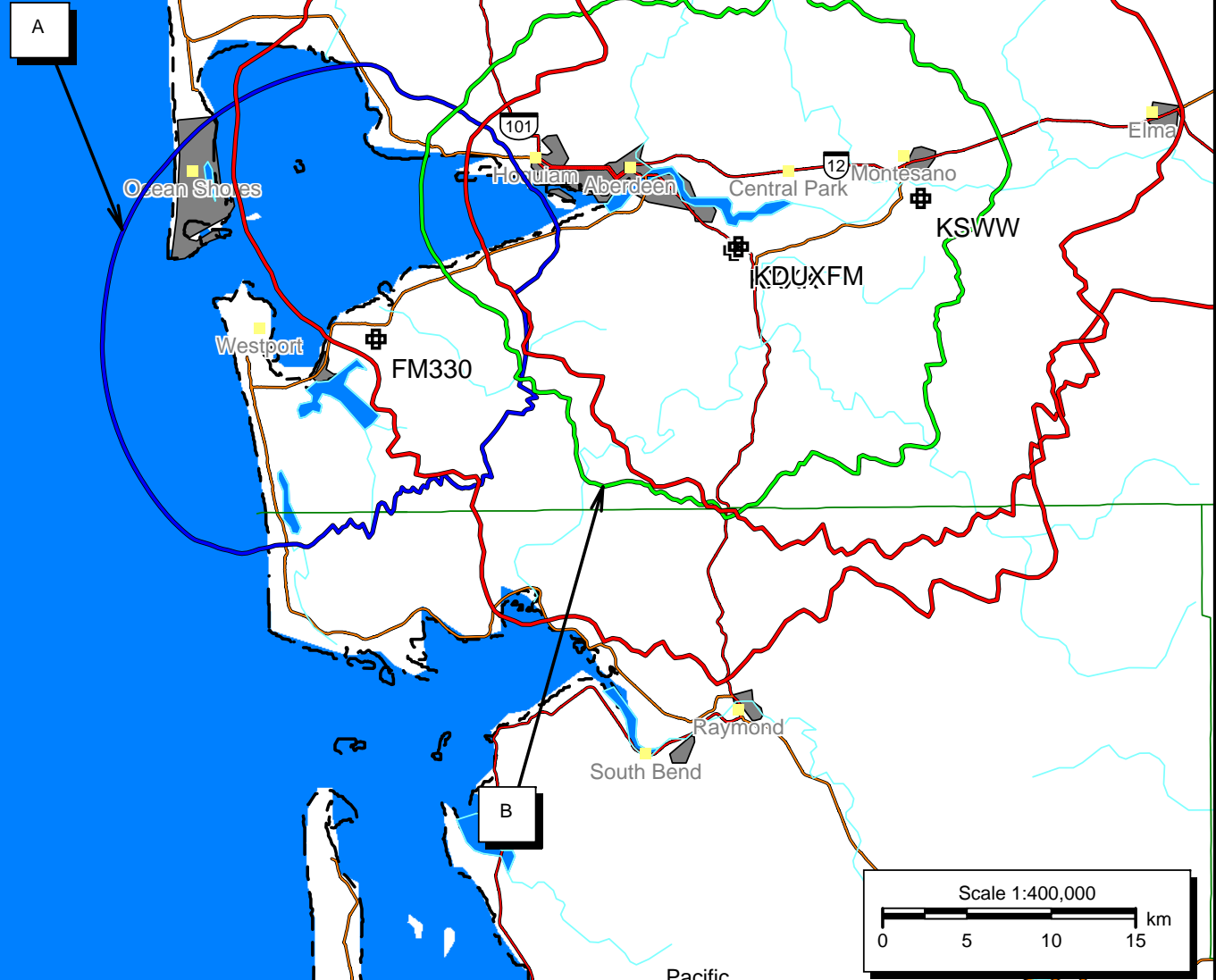
