



The attached FCC Form 340 Section V-B and associated exhibits have been prepared on behalf of *WGBH Educational Foundation* (“*WEF*”) to modify the licensed WGBH (FM) Boston, Massachusetts facility (file number BLED-800609AH). The WGBH facility is proposed to be relocated 14.9 km to an existing tower site.

The proposed site is that currently authorized for WCRB (FM), Channel 273B, Waltham, MA, as well as for television stations WGBH-TV, WBZ-TV, WCVB-TV, WCVB-DT, WBZ-DT, and WGBX-TV. Applications specifying this site are pending at the Commission for television stations WMFP-DT, WGBH-DT, and WGBX-DT. A decrease in the effective radiated power (ERP), and an increase in antenna height above average terrain (HAAT) is proposed. Continued operation in excess of the power / height limitations referenced in §73.511(b) is proposed, see **Statement C**.

Of the television stations at the proposed site, *WEF* is licensee of WGBH-TV and WGBX-TV, and has applications pending to construct a paired digital television (DTV) facility for each station. By consolidating its Boston television and radio transmitter operations at a single site, *WEF* will achieve significant savings and other efficiencies, including the sharing of facilities and personnel, reduced equipment expenditures, and lower labor cost, which will contribute to its ability to make the costly digital conversion and enhance the educational mission of its non-commercial, educational stations. In addition, by operating at greater height with better line-of-sight to downtown Boston, WGBH can improve signal reception to its community of license. Also, the new WGBH antenna will be able to accommodate additional FM stations for use as a community antenna thereby reducing the potential for construction of additional tall tower structures.

The land area within the 1 mV/m contour of the licensed WGBH facility and the gain and loss land area resulting from the proposed WGBH facility was determined by computer analysis.

NATURE OF THE PROPOSAL
(page 2 of 2)

The proposal results in a 18.6 percent change, which is a minor change as defined under §73.3573(a)(1).

This structure is currently registered with the Commission; the Antenna Structure Registration number is 1003433. The antenna structure is presently undergoing modifications that will accommodate a height increase to the authorized 395.1 meter overall above ground level (AGL) height as specified in the Antenna Structure Registration. The structure modifications and associated height change (currently underway) are associated with the construction of the various digital television station facilities and minor modifications to NTSC (analog) television stations as listed above. The present height of this structure is 365.5 meters overall AGL. The proposed FM antenna system will side-mount on the structure and will not change the overall structure height.
