

REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED PROCESSING

Davidzon Radio, Inc., licensee of Radio Station WSNR(AM), FI 61643, Jersey City, New Jersey, respectfully requests expedited processing of its minor modification application, BP-20230406AAB, to change transmitter site and for other changes.

Davidzon is party to a License Agreement with its current landlord for its transmitter site, Kingsland Development Urban Renewal, LLC, which was approved by the United States Bankruptcy Court, Eastern District of New York, case No.:1-21-40872-ess pursuant to a settlement between the parties.

The License Agreement allows for an 18 month term and 2 additional 6 month extensions. The 18 month term expires on or around July 17, 2023. Pursuant to the License Agreement and the Bankruptcy Court, no further extensions are possible. (The Notice exercising the first extension has been made).

Consequently, Davidzon MUST be licensed and operating from the transmitter site proposed in the above-referenced and currently pending application by mid-July, 2024.

The instant application proposes to relocate the WSNR transmitter site to the WPAT(AM) site and triplex

with WPAT and WNSW using a dual mode directional system.

Normally, processing of an AM modification application takes 90-120 days. Since the application was filed on April 6, 2023, conservatively, assuming no problems, one could expect the application to be granted in July or August, 2023.

Obviously, all of the equipment must be custom - designed in that a triplex operation involves filtering three AM signals. The company fabricating the equipment has been experiencing a 2-3 month backlog for the last several years. Moreover, as recent events revealed, it is impossible to predict supply chain issues and manufacturing delays for the equipment. Further, it is expected that construction could take place during the Winter of 2023-24 in northern New Jersey, another unpredictable element. Finally, measurements for a Proof of Performance must also be made before an FCC Form 302-AM can be filed and Program Test Authority issued. While July 2024 seems far in the future, complications relating to each of the above factors could easily delay this project.

Expedition of the instant application is in the Public Interest. Besides the fact that the proposed WSNR operation will significantly reduce caused and received overlap with WTEL, Philadelphia, PA, and eliminate the overlap with WEJL, Scranton, PA, early processing of the

application will allow Davidzon Radio, LLC to comply with the Bankruptcy Court's Order.

Pursuant to Court Order, WSNR must vacate its current transmitter site by July, 2024. In order to timely relocate its facilities, the licensee must consider the obstacles which could delay its successful conclusion. As a result, and in an abundance of caution, Davidzon Radio, LLC respectfully requests that the Commission expedite the processing of the instant application.
