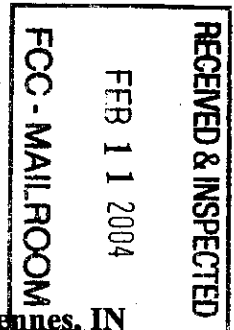


Commission records indicate that on October 23, 2000 American Family Association ("AFA") was granted a waiver of the main studio rule, Section 73.1125, in order to operate WATI(FM), Vincennes, Indiana, as a satellite station of commonly owned noncommercial educational FM station WPAC(FM), Terre Haute, Indiana.

On February 3, 2004, you filed a request to modify the WATI(FM) main studio waiver to specify noncommercial educational station, WAFR(FM), Tupelo, Mississippi, as the originating station since AFA no longer owns WPAC(FM).

In support of its request, AFA has pledged to: (1) add at least one resident of the community of Vincennes to its Community Advisory Board who will be asked to provide recommendations on community needs and programming directly to AFA management; (2) solicit listeners' opinions regarding community issues that should be addressed in programming during each regular "Sherathon" pledge drive normally held every six months; (3) track the listener responses received during the "Sherathon" in the planning of a program schedule and issues to be addressed; (4) air periodic local programming for Vincennes including coverage of significant local news or cultural events; (5) provide for the broadcast of local public service announcement; and (6) maintain a toll-free telephone number between Vincennes and the WAFR(FM) main studio.

AFA's request IS GRANTED. However, AFA is reminded that the public inspection file for WATI(FM) must now be maintained at the main studio of the new "parent" station, WAFR(FM), Tupelo, Mississippi and that the WATI(FM) public inspection file must contain the quarterly issues and programs list for Vincennes, Indiana.
