

**Technical Statement**  
**Application for Construction Permit**  
**WGWR 88.1 mHz. Liberty, NY**  
**October, 2012**

This technical statement is prepared by Charles Williamson, technical consultant to Sound of Life, Inc.(SOL), licensee of WGWR.

Currently, WGWR is operating under a Special Temporary Authority (STA) BSTA-20081203ABE as extended a number of times since December, 2008. In 2008, WGWR lost its licensed transmitter site, and efforts to save use of that site were fruitless. Another nearby site was located, and the STA was granted to permit operation at this site. WGWR subsequently received a construction permit for operation at this site however, this construction permit specifies greater power than permitted now in addition to use of a directional antenna. As detailed in the STA extension requests, WGWR has diligently worked towards building out this CP, however, expected funding has not materialized in a timely fashion. As such, rather than seek another extension of the STA, it is desired to license the facility at the existing STA location while maintaining the construction permit for the directional facility.

As such, the purpose of this application is to seek a construction permit to specify operation with the maximum power utilizing WGWR's existing Shively non-directional antenna. There is no change on the tower necessary to fulfill this application; it is simply a matter of increasing the power on the transmitter. (The existing STA operation is limited by the need to maintain the service contour within the presently licensed service contour.)

WGWR intends to build out the directional facility specified in BPED-20110211AAP in the near future once funding is finalized.
