



ENGINEERING STATEMENT

In support of an

Application for Early Transition

For Digital Channel 48

KVTJ Jonesboro, AR

780 kW ERP 297 m HAAT

PURPOSE

MARSAND, INC. has been retained by Agape Church, Inc., the licensee of KVTJ analog Channel 48 of Jonesboro, AR, to prepare this engineering statement in support of an Application for Early Transition. There is an existing Construction Permit (CP), BPCDT-2008-0318ABM, that was granted for Post-transition digital operation. In this application, KVTJ-DT seeks authorization for pre-transitional digital operation on its Channel 48 at 780 kW Effective Radiated Power (ERP) and 297 m Height Above Average Terrain (HAAT) utilizing the existing, analog non-directional antenna.

DISCUSSION

An interference study using the methods outlined in the OET 69 Bulletin confirms that the proposed facility would not exceed 2% interference to any station. A summary of the interference study is listed in **Table 1**.
