Non-Commercial Educational Objective

WFCL-FM is a non-commercial educational FM station in Nashville, Tennessee, licensed to Vanderbilt Student Communications. This application seeks assignment of WFCL-FM from Vanderbilt Student Communications to Nashville Public Radio, an existing noncommercial educational licensee whose noncommercial qualifications have already been demonstrated to the FCC in connection with its other noncommercial educational broadcast stations:

Nashville Public Radio is a non-profit corporation chartered under the laws of the State of Tennessee. The Internal Revenue Service has determined that Nashville Public Radio is an exempt organization with an educational purpose. The corporation's charter states, in part, that the purpose of Nashville Public Radio is: to provide public radio programming serving the educational, scientific, literary and charitable interests of the people of Tennessee.

The proposed new station will advance the purpose and organizational objectives of Nashville Public Radio set forth above and will further instructional, educational, and cultural purposes, as encouraged by Congress. The new station will also enhance the noncommercial educational program service of Nashville Public Radio's flagship Station WPLN-FM to the Nashville, TN area. As the licensee of noncommercial educational Station WPLN-FM, Nashville Public Radio has clearly demonstrated its commitment to, and capability of, providing valuable instructional, educational, and cultural programming.

WFCL-FM will provide classical music and arts programming for Nashville and middle Tennessee. The station will serve and enrich the community by broadcasting classical music programming in a wide variety, accompanied by educational information in music history. Additionally, WFCL serves as a nexus for the arts community by providing information to listeners about arts and educational events throughout the coverage area. WFCL will present local music performance groups and give the performers an opportunity to discuss their craft.

Specialty programs featured on WFCL include the Nashville Symphony Orchestra Concert Series, Santa Fe Chamber Festival, the New York Philharmonic Orchestra Concerts, NPR's World of Opera and the Metropolitan Opera Series., and Pipe Dreams. Each of these programs features an educational aspect, providing thoughtful and useful information on the history and theory of the music featured on the programs.

Community issues are addressed and reported during hourly newscasts from NPR weekdays from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. Information on science and the arts is also provided daily through these feature programs: BirdNote, Writers Almanac, Composer's Datebook and StarDate.

Financial Qualifications

Although Nashville Public Radio has been and continues to be engaged in a campaign to receive funds for the acquisition of Station WFCL, Nashville Public Radio's Endowment fund currently has adequate available funds for the purchase of WFCL. In addition Nashville Public Radio has operating reserves that are sufficient to cover the operating expenses of WFCL for more than 3 months.
