

LICENSEE'S EXHIBIT 9

Adverse Findings

On December 1, 2006, the Media Bureau admonished Tribune Broadcast Holdings, Inc., licensee of WTTV(TV), Bloomington, Indiana ("WTTV") and WTTK(TV), Kokomo, Indiana ("WTTK") for violating the Commission's rules limiting the amount of commercial matter that may be aired during children's programming and for violating the public inspection file document retention requirements. *See* Letter from Barbara A. Kreisman, Chief, Video Division, Media Bureau, Federal Communications Commission, to Tribune Broadcast Holdings, Inc., DA 06-2443 (released Dec. 1, 2006); Letter from Barbara A. Kreisman, Chief, Video Division, Media Bureau, Federal Communications Commission, to Tribune Broadcast Holdings, Inc., DA 06-2442 (released Dec. 1, 2006). Tribune Broadcast Holdings, Inc. is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Tribune Broadcasting Company, which in turn is wholly-owned by Tribune Company.

In their applications for renewal of license, WTTV and WTTK stated that between July 12, 2002 and April 1, 2005, there were two instances where the stations exceeded the limits on commercial matter during children's programming. The stations also reported that, subsequent to a move of the stations' studio, some items in the stations' public inspection file were missing.

The Commission granted each station's license renewal application and took no further action.
