EXPLANATION OF TRANSACTION EXHIBIT

The purpose of this application is to seek FCC consent to a transfer of control of Baraga Broadcasting, Inc., a Michigan non-profit corporation, from its original five member board of directors to an eight member board of directors. One of the five original directors, James Conboy, is retiring from the board of directors, meaning that four new directors need to have their basic qualifications passed upon by the Commission. As a non-profit corporation, Baraga Broadcasting, Inc. does not have shareholders.

The original five member board, each individual possessing 20% of the votes on the corporation's governing board, was comprised of the following individuals:
