Dear Licensee:

On May 26, 2010, the Federal Communications Commission issued a Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture³ ("NAL") finding that WSOC Television, Inc., licensee of Station WSOC-TV, Charlotte, North Carolina, willfully and repeatedly violated Section 73.670 of the Rules, by failing to comply with the limits on commercial matter in children's programming.⁴ This letter is to inform you that the Video Division does not plan to take further action relating to this matter and considers this proceeding closed. You should not construe the closing of the proceeding as a determination that the violation did not occur or finding with regards to any filing you have made in response to the NAL. The Video Division will not hesitate to take action against the Licensee for violations, including those of a similar nature, that occur in the future.
