Description EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES

CUMULUS LICENSING LLC ('CUMULUS') PREVIOUSLY REPORTED THAT AFTER REPAIRING ITS SWITCHING NETWORK, A CHANGE TO THE OVERALL HEIGHT OF ITS SUPPORTING STRUCTURES BY THE TOWER OWNER NEGATIVELY IMPACTED THE DEPTH OF THE NULLS FOR THE NIGHTTIME DIRECTIONAL ANTENNA PATTERN. ALL MONITOR POINTS WERE WITHIN SPECIFIED LIMITS. AN APPLICATION FOR A NEW PERMIT WAS FILED AND GRANTED ON JUNE 7, 2021 (BP-20210319AAJ).

AFTER THE INITIAL STA REQUEST WAS FILED, CUMULUS' LOCAL ENGINEERS MADE ADJUSTMENTS AND MEASUREMENTS TO VERIFY SYSTEM OPERATION. THE INITIAL CHECK DETERMINED THAT AT LEAST ONE OF THE SAMPLE SYSTEMS WAS OUT OF TOLERANCE. AS A RESULT, THEY PULLED THE SAMPLE SYSTEM COMPONENTS AND SENT THEM TO DELTA ELECTRONICS FOR RECALIBRATION AND TESTING.

SINCE THEN, ALL REPAIRS HAVE BEEN MADE AND A PROOF WAS COMPLETED PURSUANT TO THE PERMIT. THE READINGS INDICATE THAT THE FACILITY IS IN COMPLIANCE. THE LICENSE APPLICATION IS BEING PREPARED AND SHOULD BE FILED SOON. NO ADDITIONAL WORK IS NEEDED.

ACCORDINGLY, CUMULUS REQUESTS AN EXTENSION OF ITS STA UNTIL THE LICENSE APPLICATION IS FILED AND GRANTED.
