

**Amended Engineering Statement  
Supporting Minor Modification  
for KBLM-LP, Facility ID 38561  
File No. BPTTL-20020530ACP**


1. This Statement, prepared by Louis Martinez ("Martinez"), an engineer and licensee of station KBLM-LP, Riverside-Perris, CA, is in response to Commission letter to him dated October 11, 2002, reference 1800E2-EBK wherein the Commission denies his minor modification referenced in the above title and provided 30 days for Martinez to respond and amend. Aforesaid denial arises from applicant's objectionable interference to co-channel KNET of Los Angeles.
2. Martinez herein amends the Engineering Statement attached to his **OPPOSITION TO INFORMAL OBJECTION** filed on or about July 18, 2000 as follows: The maximum power in any direction is reduced to 25 Kw and to the horizon it is reduced to 10 Kw. The proposed new antenna pattern is withdrawn and applicant now proposes to use his currently installed and licensed pattern with increased down-tilt (to 3.4 deg) to reduce power to horizon by 4 dB. These changes will eliminate objectionable interference to co-channel KNET.
- 3) With these changes applicants KBLM 46 dBu F(50,10) contour will not traverse the KNET grade A 74 dBu contour as shown in attached figure 1 and provides the 28 dB protection required by Commission rules for offset co-channel operations.
- 4) There is no interference to other full service or low power television stations as demonstrated in prior filed Engineering Statements and the instant statement herein incorporates all those prior statements in full except to the extent herein amended. Martinez particularly wishes to comment, as previously pointed out, that there also exists terrain shielding between his KBLM and KNET, particularly in the area where their two contours are the closes, as shown in prior filed documents in this proceeding.
