Dear Mr. Basile:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 11, 2015. Digits requests an extension of the STA granted on September 19, 2014, to operate with parameters at variance from license values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within license limits due to equipment repairs.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, Digits stated that additional time is needed to allow the Commission to take final action on the pending license application BMML-20141213CQB.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KLMS(AM) may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Digits must use whatever means are necessary to

protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **August 8, 2015**.
