Educational Media Foundation ("EMF") is the licensee of FM translator station W231BS Facility ID No. 147849, Huntington, West Virginia ("Station"). This letter is written pursuant to Section 73.3517(a) of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") to grant Fifth Avenue Broadcasting Company, Inc. ("Fifth Avenue") permission to file with the FCC an application or applications in its own name to make changes in the facilities of the Station, and/or request special temporary authority (an "STA") in connection with post-closing operations of such Station. It is specifically understood that the Commission's action on any such application or applications and request for STA will be contingent upon approval of the pending application (FCC File No. BALFT-20081210AET) to assign the license for the Station from EMF to Fifth Avenue and the consummation of the transactions underlying the assignment. It is further understood that Fifth Avenue will be solely responsible for paying all filing fees and other costs associated with any such applications or STA request. If the consummation of the assignment to Fifth Avenue does not occur, Fifth Avenue will request that the FCC dismiss the application(s) or STA request as moot and return the Station to its current specifications.
