
This refers to the above-captioned FM translator application for K236BL, Del Rio, Texas.

An engineering study has revealed the application is in violation of 47 C.F.R. § 74.1231(b). Specifically, the Section states that "An FM translator may be used for the purpose of retransmitting the signals of a primary AM or FM radio broadcast station or another translator station the signal of which is received directly through space..."

The applicant proposes to rebroadcast the subcarrier of KVFE(FM) using "FMExtra/VuCast" technology. Subcarriers of an FM station are not approved to be rebroadcast on FM translators. FM stations, AM stations, LFPM stations and the IBOC signal from an FM station are the only approved signals that can be rebroadcast on FM translators. IBOC signals do not use the subcarrier of an FM station. IBOC signals use the sidebands of the existing FM station.

Accordingly, the Application BPFT-20150105ABK IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
