To verify the established local status of McNeese State University, submitted herewith are a letter from the University's President, Dr. Robert E. Hebert, and pages of facts and history from the McNeese State University website.

Diversity of Ownership

The Louisiana Constitution gives the Board of Supervisors of the University of Louisiana System the power to direct, control, supervise and manage the institutions of higher learning under its control, which includes McNeese State University. The Constitution gives the Governor of Louisiana the power and authority to appoint the members of the Board. By law the Board's powers include selecting the University's President, who is the chief executive officer of the University empowered to perform all actions to effectuate the Board's policies.

Neither the President of McNeese State University nor any member of the Board of Supervisors of the University of Louisiana System holds an attributable interest in another radio station as defined by Section 73.5555 of the Commission's Rules whose principal community contour overlaps with the one proposed in the subject application. The University and the Board and the understand their obligation to maintain this diversity over the required four-year operational period. The attached letters from the Board's Chairman and the University's President demonstrate their commitment to do so.
