TECHNICAL STATEMENT

1. This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of US Stations, LLC ("USS"), licensee of station KWXE, Glenwood, Arkansas. USS is submitting an application to relocate KWXE and change the station's community of license to Percy, Arkansas. As such, a radio market analysis is needed. USS is also the licensee of KQUS-FM, Channel 248C1, Hot Springs; KLXQ, Channel 270A, Mountain Pine; KYDL, Channel 244A, Hot Springs; KWXI, 670, Glenwood; and KZNG, 1340 kHz, Hot Springs, Arkansas. Therefore, an analysis using the revised contour overlap rules is needed. A map of the city grade contours of these stations is attached as Exhibit #1.

NON-RATED MARKET REVIEW

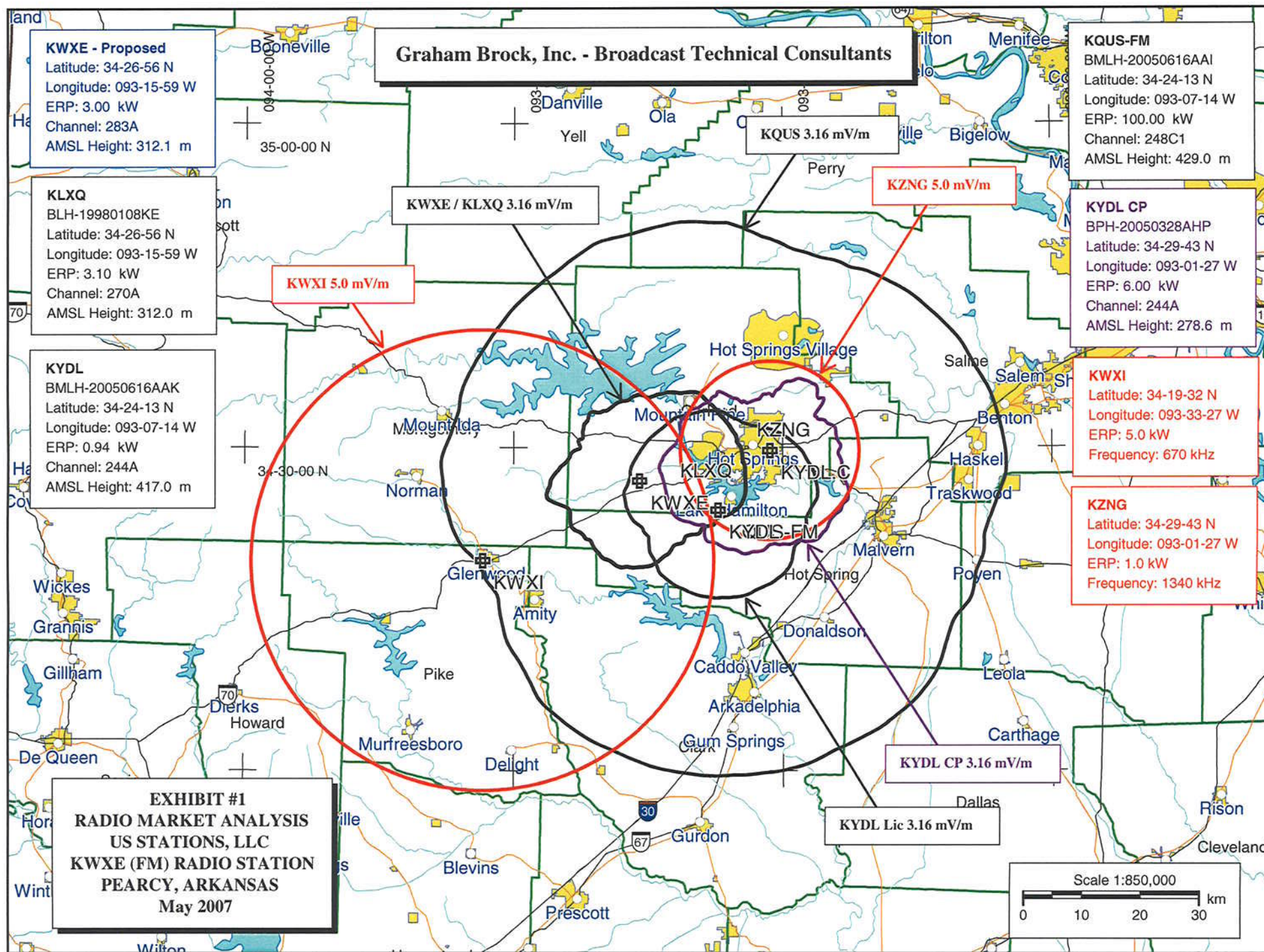
2. A study has been conducted to determine if ownership of these facilities complies with §73.3555 of the Commission's rules. Since the contours of KQUS-FM and KWXI completely encompass the contours of the other subject stations, the KQUS-FM and KWXI contours will be used to determine the number of other stations serving the defined market. The subject stations will then be added to that total. The study will determine the number of other commercial AM and FM stations that either have transmitter sites within, or provide coverage to, the subject radio

market. Only those stations with transmitter sites within 92.0 kilometers will be considered as contributors to the market. No other station in which USS has interests will be considered, unless it is a subject station in the market under review.

3. Exhibit #2 is a depiction of the other commercial and non-commercial stations within, or providing service to the KQUS-FM/KWXI Radio Market boundary. A total of twelve other stations are depicted on the map. Exhibit #3 is a tabulation of the stations in the Radio Market, a total of eighteen stations when the six subject stations are added.¹ The number of stations depicted falls in the fifteen to twenty-nine stations tier of §73.3555(a)(1)(iii) of the Commission's rules. At the fifteen to twenty-nine stations level, common ownership or control of up to six stations, with no more than four in the same service is permissible. Based on USS's interests in the above referenced stations, it is demonstrated herein that the proposed application for KWXE is in compliance with the Commission's multiple ownership rules, as detailed in §73.3555 of the rules.

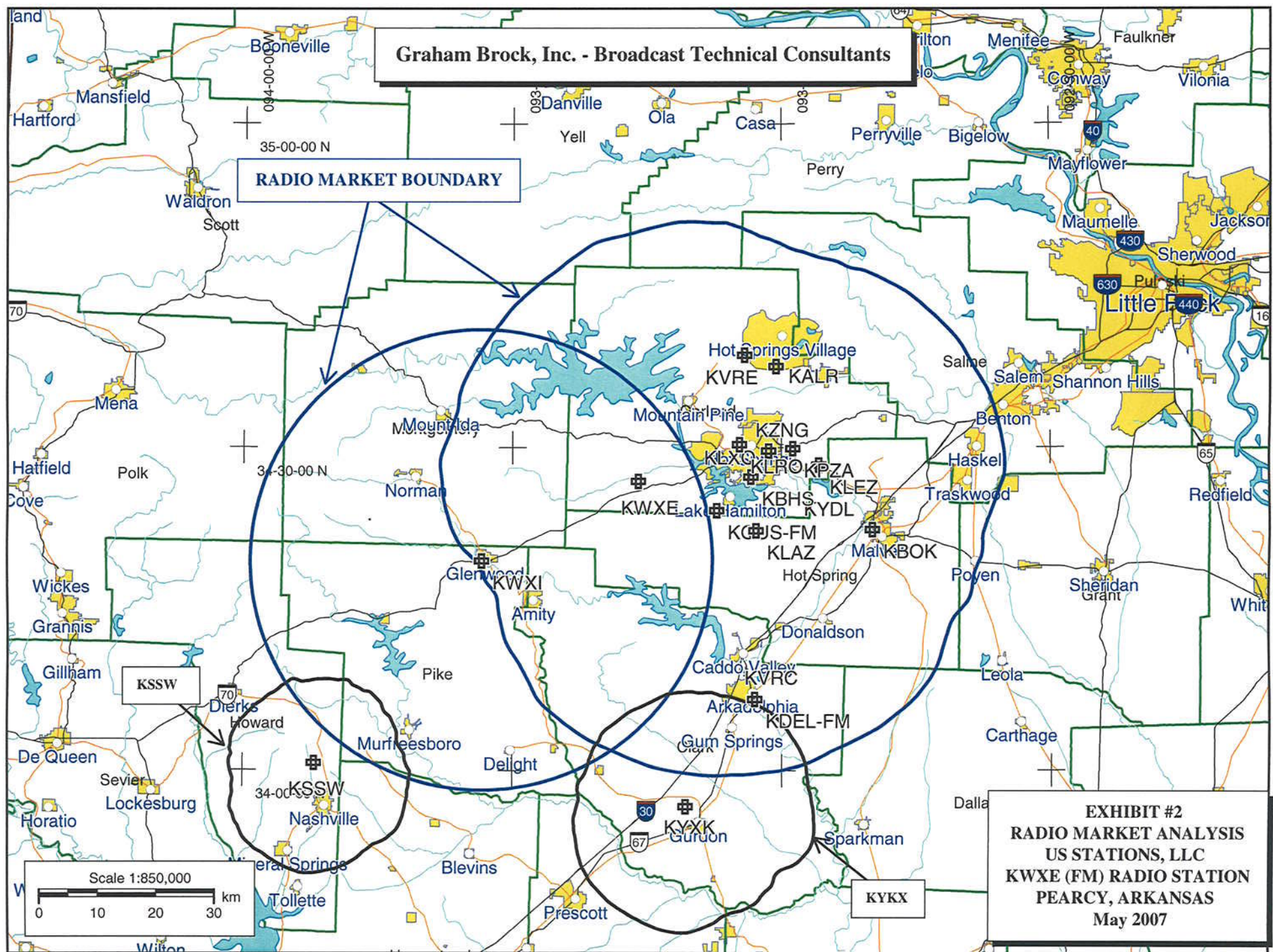


