

**AMENDMENT**

Ixoye Productions, Inc. (“Ixoye”), licensee of Non-Commercial Education Station KNLE-FM, Austin, Texas, hereby amends the above-referenced Application in order to explain the circumstances justifying Ixoye’s use of FCC Form 316 to request Commission consent to the transfer of control of Ixoye.

Randall Thomas, a 25 percent shareholder in Ixoye, died recently. Mr. Thomas was party to an agreement with Sherland Priest, also a 25 percent shareholder in Ixoye, pursuant to which Mr. Priest had the right to purchase Mr. Thomas’s interest in Ixoye upon Mr. Thomas’s death. Mr. Priest now seeks to acquire Mr. Thomas’s interest in Ixoye and become a 50 percent shareholder.

The instant transfer of control thus involves the increase of Mr. Priest’s 25 percent, non-controlling interest, to a 50 percent, negative-control interest. Ixoye submits that it is proper to seek consent to this transfer of control on FCC Form 316 pursuant to Section 73.3540(f)(3) of the Commission’s Rules, which authorizes the use of FCC Form 316 in the case of a “transfer by which certain stockholders retire and the interest transferred is not a controlling one.” *See also* Instructions for FCC 316 at 7 (Instructions for Section III – Assignee/Transferee, Section F).
