on Channel 202A (88.3 MHz)

Dear Mr. Jenkins:

KRMA consents to the filing of an application for a minor change to the current Construction Permit on Channel 202A at Fort Collins, CO. Specifically, KRMA consents to relocating the facility to the coordinates 40-37-03 by 105-19-40, with a center of radiation not to exceed 2560 meters AMSL. The ERP shall not exceed 0.15 kw (vertical only).

Educational Media Foundation has agreed to be responsible for resolving any and all interference complaints that might arise due to this change. Remedies may include the installation of TVI filters, which, if necessary, will be installed at no expense to KRMA or its viewers. The name and phone number of the person charged with resolving any problems will be supplied to KRMA prior to the completion.

KRMA reserves the right to require Educational Media Foundation to reduce power or cease operation the event that interference issues cannot be resolved to the satisfaction of KRMA, in its sole discretion.
