Request for Extension of Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Neely:

This letter concerns the request you filed on April 21, 2014, on behalf of The Association for Community Education, Inc. ("ACE"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station K219KX to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that ACE stated that Station K219KX went silent on August 15, 2013, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on November 12, 2013, and expired on May 11, 2014. ACE requests extension of its STA for continuing technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

ACE's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K219KX to remain silent until August 15, 2014. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K219KX will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., August 16, 2014.**<sup>1</sup> See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
