Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to the request filed by G.I.G., Inc. (the "Licensee"), seeking reinstatement of the license and the call sign for station KVNJ-LP, Fargo, North Dakota (the "Station").

In a letter dated March 12, 2014, the Video Division canceled the Station's license for failing to file a license renewal application, which the Licensee was required to file by December 1, 2014. On April 2, 2014, the Licensee filed its license renewal application and the necessary filing fee.¹ Simultaneously, the Licensee filed a request to reinstate the Station's license. In its request for reinstatement, the Licensee describes the Commission's action as "draconian" and states that it "did not have the financial resources to timely file its renewal applications."

Absent a more comprehensive showing of the Station's financial plight we do not find this statement alone to be a valid excuse for the Licensee's failure to file a license renewal application in a timely manner. Nonetheless, because the Station's license was prematurely canceled prior to the expiration date listed on the Station's license, April 1, 2014, the request for reinstatement filed by G.I.G., Inc. **IS HEREBY GRANTED**, and the license and call sign for KVNJ-LP, Fargo, North Dakota, **IS REINSTATED**. Furthermore, we remind the Licensee of its obligation to comply and become familiar with all relevant statutes and Commission rules.² We do not rule out sanctions in the future for violations of a similar nature.
