Dear Licensee:


The Commission's AM engineering database record for Station WNTN includes a "Plan" record for nighttime secondary operation with 3 watts, pursuant to an Order to Show Cause issued in MM Docket No. 87-131. However, our records do not indicate receipt of a letter from the licensee which either 1) notified the Commission of intent to operate with the nighttime secondary power, or 2) stated the licensee's intention not to operate at night and requested deletion of the "Plan" record.

Consequently, if Station WNTN is operating at night pursuant to the Order to Show Cause, it is necessary to notify the Commission by letter, stating that it is the intent of Colt Communications, LLC to operate Station WNTN during nighttime hours pursuant to the Order to Show Cause, and stating the means by which the operating power will be reduced to 3 watts. Upon receipt of the notification letter, we will convert the "Plan" record to a license record.

On the other hand, if Colt Communications, LLC does not wish to operate at night with the reduced nighttime secondary power specified in the Order to Show Cause, you may notify the Commission to that effect and we will delete the "Plan" record from the database. Note that, once this step is taken, in order to obtain nighttime operating authority for Station WNTN at any future time, it will be necessary to file an application for construction permit in compliance with the Commission's technical rules. In that event, there is no guarantee that nighttime power equal to that specified in the "Plan" record could be authorized.
