Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed December 19, 2006, on behalf of Calvary Chapel of Albuquerque, Inc. ("CCA"). CCA requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on September 18, 2006, to operate Station KL YT with reduced power.<sup>1</sup>

In support of the request, CCA states that KL YT facilities were damaged by lightning and that replacement parts are on hand awaiting installation. Subsequent to the filing of the request, counsel advised the staff via e-mail that CCA intends to replace its transmitter.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed

operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KLYT may continue to operate with reduced power. CCA must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. CCA must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **April 1, 2008**.
