Dear Licensee:

We have before us your STA request for K266BM. We also have an informal objection against your STA filed January 31, 2020 by Bicoastal Media Licenses IV, LLC ("Bicoastal").

Bicoastal's informal objection points out that the 60 dBu service contour from the operation proposed in your STA extends substantially beyond the location of the licensed and directional 60 dBu service contour. This situation, Bicoastal contends, is inconsistent with the Audio Division's policy of limiting STA operations to areas within the licensed service contour. Therefore, Bicoastal asks the Division to dismiss your STA request.

Bicoastal's assessment is correct. We do not grant STA requests to extend service beyond the licensed 60 dBu service contour absent compelling circumstances. Such circumstances are not present here. Therefore, we grant Bicoastal's informal objection, and your STA request is dismissed.

This action does not preclude you from filing a new, acceptable STA proposal.
