PacificStar Media Corporation ("PacificStar"), licensee of commercial AM radio broadcast station WPBS(AM), 1040 kHz, Conyers, Georgia (Facility ID No. 42070, "WPBS"), by its counsel, respectfully requests a waiver of Section 73.1560(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 73.1560(a), to permit use of Modulation Dependent Carrier Level ("MDCL") technology with the AM transmitter for WPBS. This waiver request is being submitted in accordance with the procedures announced by the Commission in its Public Notice, DA 11-1535 (released September 13, 2011, the "MDCL Waiver Public Notice").

Grant of the waiver would serve the public interest by allowing WPBS to "reduce power consumption while maintaining both audio quality and licensed coverage areas". See MDCL Waiver Public Notice at 1. WPBS operates with an NX series transmitter from Nautel Inc. ("Nautel"), specifically an NX50 transmitter from Nautel, which uses Amplitude Modulation Comanding ("AMC"), a transmitter and MDCL technologies specifically recognized by the Commission in the MDCL Waiver Public Notice. Id. at 1-2 and n.4. WPBS currently operates with the NX50 transmitter which already is equipped with the MDCL technology, so the change would be implemented simply by enabling the MDCL option in the transmitter upon grant of the waiver request. PacificStar would cooperate with the field strength measurement programs of other stations by temporarily disabling the MDCL at WPBS upon request.
