Second Amendment to Minor Change Application (BPED-20070906AAR) WLJP, Monroe, NY January, 2007

The purpose of this second amendment is to correct the directional pattern so that it is in full compliance with 73.510 & 73.316.

On September 5, 2007, WSGG filed an application for a change in facilities. On September 6, 2007, WLJP filed an application for a change in facilities (FCC File Number BPED-20070906AAR). Due to the simultaneous preparation of each application, WLJP protected the WSGG licensed facility, but not the (unknown) minor change application. This created an MX condition that WLJP removed with its first amendment on November 28, 2007.

By way of this second amendment, as directed by FCC Staff, WLJP is modifying its directional antenna design to maintain full compliance with 73.510 and subsequently 73.316.

Contained within Exhibit 15 is an Amended Interference Study showing the WSGG application, and its protection. Additionally, an Amended Contour Map is provided along with an Amended TV6 Contour Map.
