Special Temporary Authority

Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed December 14, 2011, on behalf of Community Broadcasting, Inc. ("CBI"). CBI requests special temporary authority ("STA") to operate FM Translator K209EC with temporary facilities.¹ In support of the request, CBI states that it has filed an application for permanent relocation of the station concurrently with the STA extension request.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made substantial progress toward restoring licensed operation. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station K209EC may operate with the following facilities:

¹ K209EC is licensed for operation on Channel 209D (89.7 MHz) with effective radiated power of 0.205 kilowatt (V only) and antenna height above average terrain of 81 meters.

CBI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. The action taken herein is without prejudice as to the Commission's final action with regard to any subsequently filed application for construction permit. Any construction undertaken pursuant to this authority is entirely at CBI's own risk.

This authority expires on **September 2, 2012**.

Notwithstanding the grant of this STA or the expiration date specified herein, the station's license will expire as a matter of law upon twelve consecutive months of silence. *See* Pub. Law No. 104-104, 110 Stat. 56, Section 403(1) (1996) and *Order, Silent Station Authorizations*, FCC 96-218 (released May 17, 1996). *See also Public Notice*, Expedited Processing of Applications Filed by Silent Stations, DA 96-818 (May 22, 1996). The licensee must notify the Audio Division immediately upon resumption of broadcasting.
