

TUCK ANALYSIS FOR SPRINGDALE AND COLUMBIA

Springdale is an incorporated town in Lexington County and Columbia is located in Richland County. Springdale has a population of 2,877 and Columbia has a population of 116,278, which represents about 2% of the population of Columbia. In Chillicothe, Ohio, 18 FCC Rcd 22410 (MB 2003), the smaller community had less than 1% of the population of the central city.

The community reference point for Springdale is 8.2 km. west of the Columbia reference point. The proposed 5.0 mV/m signal will cover 45% of the population of the Columbia Urbanized Area and 36.6% of the land area. In Mullins and Briarcliffe Acres, SC, 14 FCC 10516 (MMB 1999), 67% of the urbanized area was covered by the primary signal.

Factor 1. The major employers located in Lexington County in the area adjacent to Springdale are Time Warner Cable, Harland Clark Industries, NCR, UPS, Fedex, Solectron, and the Pella Corporation. According to the Central Midlands Council of Government, Lexington County has 106,222 employed residents, and 42,595 work in Columbia or Richlands County. Thus, over half of the residents of Springdale work in nearby areas of Lexington County. In Anniston, AL, 16 FCC Rcd 3411 (MMB 2001), 16% of the community's workforce being employed in the community was sufficient.

Factor 2. The local government has its own internet website, which is www.springdalesc.com.

Factor 3. Community residents and leaders perceive Springdale to be independent of Columbia. See attached statements.

Factor 4. Springdale was incorporated in 1955 and has its own town government with a Mayor and Council.

Factor 5. Springdale uses zip code 29170.

Factor 6. Many businesses use the name Springdale. They include Mayberry's of Springdale; Springdale Stylon; Springdale Pharmacy; and the Springdale Shopping Center. There is also the Springdale Baptist Church and the Springdale Elementary School.

Factor 7. Advertisers can direct their advertising to Springdale through the local government website.

Factor 8. The Springdale town government provides police and public works to its residents. No municipal services or schools are provided by the city of Columbia.

In view of all the foregoing, Springdale should be considered independent of Columbia.
