Dear Mr. Liberman:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 26, 2013. TMBL requests extension of the STA granted on August 15, 2012.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, TMBL states that although some antenna system repairs have been completed in the past six months, the replacement tower has not yet been installed.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WYOS may continue to operate with a temporary emergency non-directional antenna and reduced power



not to exceed 1.25 kW day and 0.125 kW night. It is anticipated that TMBL will file a direct measurement of power application on FCC Form 302 in order to verify all operating parameters before the expiration date shown. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. TMBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **February 22, 2014**.
